### Important Parking & Shuttle Information

Due to last year's parking and congestion problems, *parking on* and *walking to* Whiskey Island will be **strictly prohibited** for Burning River Fest event goers. BUT, we have a lot of remedies to offer this year:

**RTA Public Transportation:** RTA will operate special event bus service to Edgewater Park for the Fest on Saturday, August 11, 2007. The service will operate frequently between the West Blvd/Cudell Red Line Station and Edgewater Park from 12:30 PM until approximately 10:00 PM (free "Precious Cargo" shuttle buses will then take passengers to/from Edgewater Park to/from the front gate of Burning River Fest on Whiskey Island). Parking at the West Blvd/Cudell Station is very limited. Those planning to drive should park at one of the following rapid transit stations that have large park-n-ride lots:

**Green Line Station**

**Edgewater Park:** Free "Precious Cargo" shuttle buses will run to/from the clearly marked Edgewater Park grass lot directly to/from the front gate of Burning River Fest on Whiskey Island from 12:30 PM until approximately 10:00 PM. Free, but limited, vehicle parking will only be available in this parking lot as space allows.

**Max Hayes High School:** Free "Precious Cargo" shuttle buses will run to/from the Max Hayes High School parking lot (4600 Detroit Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio 44102) directly to/from the front gate of Burning River Fest on Whiskey Island from 12:30 PM until approximately 10:00 PM. Free, but limited, vehicle parking will only
